  In a statement issued by the White House on Women's Health Week, President Trump expanded his support for paid family leave to fathers.


  A report estimated that President Trump's tax plan would cut taxes by more than \$15 million a year for the top 400 earners, totaling \$5 billion in tax cuts.


  GOP women in the House cited sexion as the reason why many of them are retiring or running for higher office instead of aiming for leadership positions in their party. Women comprise less than 10 percent of House Republicans and no woman has ever filled any of the top three leadership positions in the party.

  The U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission reached a settlement with insurance broker Brown & Brown, Inc. The company was changed with violating Tile VII of the civil Rights Act of 1964 when it rescinded a job first to a woman after learning of her pregnancy.

  Sen. Jeannes Phalesen (D-NH) introduced the Keeping Girts in School Act on Thursday. The bill, which will allocate \$35 million to help girds around the world get an education, is intended to put the mission of Michele Doama's discontinued Let Girls Learn program into law.

  The Organ Equal Pay Act of 2017 is headed to Gov. Kate Brown's (D-OR) desk after unainmous passage. AAUW of Oregon members worked tirelessly to ensure that a strong bill made it through the legislative process, even earning a shout-out on the Senate Goor from Republican Deputy Leader Tim Knopp (R-Bend), who referenced AAUW's decades of work on the Issue along with the Association of Collegiate Alumnae (AAUW's predecesor) and its 1896 report on pay equity.
